

WORKING SESSIONS

INTRODUCTION

The 3D Cadastre Workshop includes four working sessions:

1. Legal framework for 3D Cadastres;
2. Initial registration of 3D parcels;
3. 3D data management;
4. Visualization, distribution and delivery of 3D parcels.

The overall objective is to provide feedback to the FIG Commission 3 (Spatial Information Management) and FIG Commission 7 (Cadastre and Land Management) and EuroSDR.

There will be working sessions on three consecutive days. On the first two days this will consist of separate discussions by the four different groups. The chairpersons are expected to keep notes on the discussions, or appoint a secretary. A five-minutes summary will be given to each working group on the second day, and a ten-minutes presentation will be given to the whole workshop on each of the specific working sessions, followed by a plenary discussion, in order to prepare our recommendations to the FIG commissions and EuroSDR. The summaries will be processed and handed over to the FIG and EuroSDR (and also made available on the workshop website <http://3dcadastres2011.nl>).

We expect that, as far as possible, each discussion will be organized around:

- What is the problem to be addressed;
- What are the potential solutions;
- What is the progress with respect to the 1st International Workshop on 3D Cadastres (2001).
- What are our recommendations;
